

A*−C **1** 65.3%









CCEA Analytics



- A free online tool which provides schools with the ability to carry out an analysis of their GCSE, AS and A Level results;
- Provides schools with 3 years' data to benchmark the performance of their school;
- Provides data to centres in a meaningful way graphically presented
- Allows the measuring and comparing of a centre's performance at subject, component and question level to that of other centres; and
- Highlights strengths and areas for improvement.




