LMC celebrate 25 years of its education programme

LMC's education programme has been committed to increasing pupils understanding on the importance of beef and lamb as part of a balanced diet and championing the Northern Ireland Beef and Lamb Farm Quality Assurance Scheme.

Launched in 1999, the early education programme focussed heavily on the provision of cookery demonstrations and supporting educational resources for post primary schools. While this remains an integral part of the programme, over the last two decades it has further evolved, offering support to pupils and teachers in a wide variety of ways.

In the last 25 years LMC has been successful in the delivery of teacher workshops, teacher conferences, educational competitions, thousands of cookery demonstrations and dozens of educational resources. One of the more recent and exciting developments was the move to extend LMC's education programme to Key Stage 2 pupils. The primary programme launched fully in 2022 following a successful pilot the year prior.

Since then, it has continued to gather momentum, with 100 primary demonstrations delivered in the last academic year. There's lots of plans in the pipeline to help celebrate this milestone anniversary, so keep an eye out on our website and social media pages over the coming months!

LMC launch new primary school recipe book

An exciting new classroom resource designed for Key Stage 2 pupils has been developed and published by the Livestock and Meat Commission (LMC).

The primary school booklet brings together tasty beef and lamb recipes with educational resources on topics including a balanced diet, the farm to fork story and the environment around us.

The booklet aims to support the cookery demonstrations and reinforce key messaging around Northern Ireland Farm Quality Assured (NIFQA) beef and lamb in an engaging way. There are a host of easy to cook beef and lamb recipes included in the booklet that are excellent for encouraging children to become actively involved in meal preparation, supporting the development of life-long practical skills.

The recipes are tailored to suit in-class cooking, but also make perfect family meals at home! LMC's primary school education booklets will be distributed by cookery demonstrators during demonstrations. For more information and to view additional resources visit food4life.org.uk.

Demonstrations will take place within the classroom and last approximately 40 minutes. The LMC demonstrator will demonstrate a beef or lamb recipe, with pupils given an opportunity to sample the dish at the end of the demonstration.
